Community Visitors Scheme

CVS is a program funded by the Australian Government, which aims to enrich the quality of life of people by having social contact from a friendly community visitor.

How does the program work?

A community visitor is a volunteer who is matched with a senior and regularly visits their new friend in their home (normally fortnightly). Visits should be spent doing something you both enjoy such as chatting, playing a game of cards, or you may want to go for a short stroll or take a seat together in the garden.

Why join the program?

- Have a Community Visitor visit you at your home
- Make new friends
- Share your experiences
- Have fun
- If you have any concerns we may be able to help by referring you to other services.

Home Modifications

Home Modification services are subsidised by the government for eligible *Commonwealth Home Support Programme* (CHSP) clients generally up to 50% of cost, however there is some flexibility. Clients are provided with a free, no obligation quote for works.

Minor home modifications may include:

- Grab rails in shower/bathroom
- Internal / external ramps & rails
- Hand-held showers, lever tap turners
- Step modifications
- Installing wedges and small access ramps
- Installing lever door handles
- Removal of shower screens/doors and installation of weighted shower curtain
- Widening of pathways

Complex modifications require assessment by an Occupational Therapist, to ensure the modifications suit individual functional needs.

Home & Garden Maintenance

Home Maintenance services are subsidised by the government for eligible CHSP clients. Clients can choose to have services on an agreed regular basis or as requested when the need arises (subject to availability).

Home maintenance may include:

- Security locks, repairing doors & window
- Repair flooring to fix slip and trip hazards
- Working-at-height related repairs or cleaning for client health and safety i.e. gutters, roofs, smoke alarms
- Other repairs & maintenance for safety.

Garden maintenance may include:

• Lawn mowing, spraying, pruning etc.

CHSP subsidised rates are available from \$25* p/h for rostered lawns clients. Home maintenance from \$55* p/h, plus tip fees and material costs if applicable. Additional charges apply where external contractors required.

Individual Social Support (CHSP)

We offer social support to help you participate in community life and maintain social connections. CHSP Individual Social Support services include:

- Accompanied activities: such as to assist you through accompanied shopping, bill-paying, attendance at appointments etc. Negotiable contribution fee \$15 p/h.
- **Social visiting**: a volunteer or staff member will visit you in your home or call for a chat, this is a social visit and not for domestic or other services purposes.
